It has recently come to our attention that UAW Local 2865, the union representing Academic Student Employees (ASEs), stands ready to bargain in good faith over compensation for ASEs at the University of California.

It is also our understanding that the University has expressed an unwillingness to reopen the collective bargaining agreement covering the ASEs.

The statement released on February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020 in which the UC Office of the President invited the UC Graduate and Professional Council (UCGPC) to a meeting to discuss the situation was inappropriate as UCGPC is not the union representing ASEs and is not the correct entity with which to negotiate the collective bargaining agreement.

We strongly encourage the University to reopen the collective bargaining agreement and begin negotiating with UAW Local 2865 so that common ground can be reached on compensation for Academic Student Employees.
